

**DAYTON INTERNATIONAL FESTIVAL, INC.
GUIDELINES AND RULES FOR DISPENSING / SERVING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES**

- 1. Only those persons at least 21 years of age may buy alcoholic beverages.**
- 2. Only persons at least 21 years of age may dispense and/or sell alcoholic beverages.**
- 3. No person shall sell alcoholic beverages to any person under 21 years of age, or buy alcoholic beverages for, or furnish, alcoholic beverages to any person under 21 years of age.**
- 4. The patron (buyer) must provide proof of age at the Wristband Booth to receive a wristband prior to purchasing OR consuming alcoholic beverages.**
- 5. Alcoholic Beverages are NOT to be sold or given to anyone who is not wearing a wristband (regardless of age).**
- 6. The cashier (in addition to the person dispensing alcoholic beverages) must be at least 21 years of age.**
- 7. No person under 18 years of age is allowed in the serving area.**
- 8. NO alcoholic beverages are to be given without charge (not even “samples” or “tastes”). This does not include Beer Passport holders, since this is a pre-paid situation.**
- 9. Selling alcoholic beverages at half price or giving away after closing time is not allowed.**
- 10. Sales of alcoholic beverages MUST cease one-half hour prior to closing time each day of the festival.**
- 11. No alcoholic beverages are to be sold to intoxicated persons. The seller reserves the right to refuse service to any person. (Should a person appear to be intoxicated and insists upon being served, security shall be called.)**
- 12. No improper conduct, indecent language, or disturbances shall be allowed in the area – either on the part of the patron or seller.**
- 13. All alcoholic beverages MUST be served in plastic or paper containers. Bottles are not to be give to customers under any circumstances.**
- 14. Alcoholic beverages must be served in colored plastic cups/containers. (Non-alcoholic beverages shall be served in clear cups/containers.)**
- 15. Sale of mixed drinks must be prepared and dispensed according to the guidelines prescribed in another document.**
- 16. It is illegal to remove any alcoholic beverages from the designated premises or to consume said beverages off such premises or outside the exhibit area. Alcoholic beverages cannot be taken into the lobby area.**
- 17. No carry out sales are allowed.**
- 18. Brand name or manufacturer of name of all alcoholic beverages must be displayed on the dispensing apparatus.**
