

**DAYTON INTERNATIONAL FESTIVAL, INC.
GUIDELINES AND RULES FOR DISPENSING / SERVING ALCOHOLIC
BEVERAGES**

1. You must be at least 21 years of age to buy beer, wine or intoxicating liquor (collectively alcoholic beverages).
2. You must be 21 years of age to consume alcoholic beverages.
3. No person shall sell alcoholic beverages to any person under 21 years of age, or buy alcoholic beverages for, or furnish it to, a person under 21 years of age.
4. **The patron must provide proof of age at the ID Table and receive a wristband prior to purchasing OR consuming alcoholic beverages**
5. **Alcoholic beverages are NOT to be sold or given to anyone who is not wearing a wristband.**
6. You may not give away any alcoholic beverages.
7. **The person dispensing alcoholic beverages (bartender) must be 21 years of age.**
8. **The cashier must be 18 years of age.**
9. **No person under 18 years of age is allowed in serving area.**
10. Do not sell any alcoholic beverages to an intoxicated person.
11. You have the right to refuse to serve alcoholic beverages to anyone.
12. Do not allow any improper conduct, indecent language, entertainment or disturbances on the property.
13. **All alcoholic beverages must be served in plastic or paper containers.**
14. **Bottles are not to be given to customers under any circumstances.**
15. No selling of alcoholic beverages at half price or selling or giving away after closing time.
16. It is illegal to remove any alcoholic beverages from the designated permit premises or to consume it off such premises or outside of exhibit area and cannot be taken into the lobby area. No carry out privileges allowed.
17. Intoxicating liquor (wine, etc; not beer) cannot be sold before 1:00 PM on Sunday.
18. Brand name or name of the manufacturer of beer and wine must be displayed on dispensing apparatus
